Biman issues front row seats to hajj pilgrims on firstcome-first-serve basis

Dhaka: Biman Bangladesh Airlines has decided to issue front row seats to 2022's Hajj pilgrims on first-come-first-serve basis.

Pilgrims flying on the national flag carrier will have to pay USD 150 (some BDT 13,385) extra for one-way travel from Bangladesh to Saudi Arabia.

Whereas, a roundtrip on the front cabin of Biman will cost USD 250 (around BDT 22,309) more.

The fee for coming home from Saudi Arabia has been set at SAR 700 (BDT 16,654). However, passengers availing of this offer will not be subjected to any special services.

Besides, the offer only stands for special hajj flights being operated by Biman.
