By leveraging these codeshare connections, customers will have access to 18 destinations in India, offering a wider range of options for tourists, business travelers, and leisure seekers. Both airlines look forward to further expanding their cooperation in the future, offering even greater convenience and travel options.

For travel starting December 16, 2024, reservation and ticket sales will be available from December 4, 2024.
