

UAE seeks BD govt support to operate Wizz Air flights to Dhaka/Ctg

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Dhaka : The United Arab Emirates (UAE) sought cooperation from the Bangladesh government for operation of Abu Dhabi-based Wizz Air flights between Abu Dhabi and Dhaka/Chittagong.

Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates to Bangladesh Abdullah Ali Al Hamoudi met Foreign Minister Dr AK Abdul Momen at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on December 11 and discussed issues of mutual interest.

Foreign Minister Momen said the relationship between Bangladesh and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) is becoming stronger day by day.

He listened to the envoy and assured of full cooperation. Momen further stressed to strengthen cooperation on food security, energy security and climate change issues between Bangladesh and the UAE.

The UAE envoy expressed his country's interests to scale up the bilateral engagements between the two countries.
