

EBL managing toll collection of Chattogram Elevated Expressway

Chattogram : Eastern Bank PLC will be managing toll collection and deposit services of the recently inaugurated Shaheed Wasim Akram Flyover, known as Chattogram Elevated Expressway, in the port city.

Chattogram Development Authority (CDA) has partnered with Eastern Bank PLC (EBL) to enhance toll collection efficiency and financial transparency. Engineer Md Nurul Karim, Chairman of Chattogram Development Authority, and Ali Reza Iftikhar, Managing Director and CEO of EBL, signed an agreement to this effect at Hotel Agrabad, Chattogram, on February 10.
