

Air Traffic Management Center to be inaugurated tomorrow

Dhaka: The Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh (CAAB) is set to inaugurate a state-of-the-art Air Traffic Management (ATM) Center tomorrow, marking a significant milestone in the country's aviation sector.

The inauguration ceremony will be held on April 20 at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka, according to a press invitation letter.
