

Desert beats, Dhaka dreams: Riyadh's Soundstorm music fest could be Bangladesh's next global gateway

When the golden dunes outside Riyadh start pulsing to global beats this December, it will not just be another concert weekend — it will be a statement of how far the Middle East's music scene has come, and how deeply it is connecting with South Asia.

From December 11 to 13, Saudi's capital will host MDLBEAST's **Soundstorm 2025,** one of the world's most ambitious music festivals often dubbed the "Coachella of the East". Over three days, the desert will transform into a sprawling playground of sound and light, featuring four themed districts, fourteen monumental stages, and hundreds of international and regional artists performing for tens of thousands of fans from around the globe.

Headliners such as Post Malone, Cardi B, Halsey, Pitbull, Benson Boone, and Calvin Harris will join emerging and regional talents, cementing Soundstorm's status as the Middle East's biggest cultural phenomenon.

New gateway for South Asian artists

The festival's parent company, MDLBEAST, has been expanding its creative ecosystem — organizing the XP Music Futures conference, talent incubators, and collaboration programs that connect regional musicians with international producers and booking agents.

South Asian artists have already begun appearing on smaller Soundstorm stages, and more are expected in the coming years. For Bangladeshi DJs, electronic producers, and indie performers — from the vibrant scenes of Dhaka, Chattogram, and Sylhet — this could be a gateway to the global festival circuit.

With Bangladesh's youth-driven music scene thriving — from Coke Studio Bangla to underground electronic collectives — the timing could not be better. Participation in events like Soundstorm could elevate local talent onto international stages, while introducing global audiences to Bangladesh's distinct rhythms and storytelling traditions.



Celebration for Bangladeshi diaspora

Soundstorm 2025 carries special significance for the 3 million Bangladeshis that live and work in Saudi. It is not only a world-class entertainment event but a moment of belonging — a rare chance for the Bangladeshi diaspora to gather, celebrate, and connect beyond work and routine life.

In cities like Riyadh, Jeddah, and Dammam, the Bangladeshi community forms a vital part of the Saudi's social and economic fabric. Yet opportunities for cultural recreation and artistic exchange have traditionally been limited. Soundstorm changes that.

For expatriate families, the festival is becoming more than just a party; it is a shared cultural experience that brings together people from across nationalities, professions, and generations.

For Bangladeshi travelers, the festival also opens a new travel corridor — a six-hour flight from Dhaka to Riyadh — leading to a destination that now offers both modern excitement and deep-rooted tradition.

Ticket options range from the STORM all-access pass to the luxury VIB Experience, while travel bundles combine festival entry with curated tours, heritage experiences, and Red Sea excursions.
