

2 Russian passengers offloaded for misbehaving with crew at new Goa airport

In yet another shocking incident of unruly behaviour, 2 Russian passengers were offloaded from a Go First flight at Manohar International airport in Goa for misbehaving and abusing crew members.

The international passengers allegedly asked the crew members to sit next to them during the safety briefing.

As per reports, the passengers also abused and made fun of the crew, a Go First official said.

A spokesperson of Go First said, "Upon abusing the crew, two foreign nationals were offloaded. They were actually teasing the crew, passing comments and remarks on her. They were in the emergency seats, and a security briefing was taking place at the time. The co-passengers also objected to their behaviour.

The airline official also said, "The matter was reported to the pilot in command and a warning was given to the passengers. They, however, continued to misbehave."

A DGCA official said, "Upon landing, both passengers were offloaded by the airline security staff and handed over to the local police. We have been informed of the matter."

The incident comes just a few days after the Air India incident, where a drunk passenger urinated on an elderly co-passenger on a New York-Delhi business class flight.
