

3-day Int'l tourism fair begins in the city tomorrow

Dhaka: After a break of over two years, the long awaited international travel and tourism fair Dhaka Travel Mart will begin at the Ball Room of Pan Pacific Sonargaon Hotel in the city tomorrow, June 2. State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism, Md. Mahbub Ali, MP will formally inaugurate the fair as the Chief Guest.

This year, a total of about 50 organisations, representing national tourism organisations, airlines, tour operators, hotels, resorts, travel agencies, online travel agencies, healthcare service providers from home and abroad are taking part in the DTM 2022.

Visitors during 3 days of the fair will enjoy attractive offers from the participating organizations including discounts on air tickets and hotel accommodation, tour packages among many others.
