

Air Arabia adds third daily flight to Bangkok

Dhaka: Air Arabia, the Middle East and North Africa's first and largest low-cost carrier (LCC), has announced the expansion of its services to Bangkok, Thailand, with the introduction of a second daily flight effective 26th October 2025.

The enhancement in frequency between Sharjah International Airport and Suvarnabhumi International Airport in Bangkok reflects Air Arabia's continued commitment to offering customers greater travel flexibility, improved connectivity, and enhanced convenience between the United Arab Emirates and Thailand.
