

Akasa Air begins its maiden flight from Chennai

Akasa Air inaugurated its first flight from Chennai on Saturday, the fifth metropolis in its community, enabling the airline to supply twice-daily flights in every course on the Chennai-Bengaluru route.

Additional increasing its operations from Chennai, the airline will begin one further each day flight from September 15 on the Chennai-Mumbai route and can add a further each day flight on the Chennai-Bengaluru route from September 26.

As well as, strengthening its pan-India community connectivity, the airline has additionally added a brand new route between Chennai and Kochi, which is able to start from September 26.

This fast enlargement of cities, routes and frequencies is in keeping with the airline's imaginative and prescient of adopting a phased however fast strategy to develop its community throughout India.

"We have now achieved one more milestone in the present day with the launch of economic flights from Chennai, which is the fifth metropolis in our community. From in the present day, we are going to provide double-daily flights in every course on this new route," IANS quoted Praveen Iyer, Co-founder and Chief Business Officer, Akasa Air, as saying.

"Inside the subsequent 5 days, we are going to strengthen our community from Chennai by connecting to Mumbai, the monetary capital of India, which is able to change into operational from September 15. On September 26, with the beginning of the Chennai-Kochi route we are going to additional strengthen our connectivity from Chennai."

Iyer added, “The elevated capacities throughout these key focus cities backed by reasonably priced fares will present our clients many choices to select from whereas planning their journey. We’re delighted to reinforce our community to satisfy our dedication of progressively including extra cities alongside new sectors.” The airline began its industrial operations with two plane and has subsequently obtained 4 plane until now.

It’ll proceed to develop its fleet with a view to ascertain a robust pan-India presence with a deal with key cities and metro to tier-2 and three route connectivity.

Akasa Air’s fleet dimension might be 18 plane by the top of March 2023 and over the subsequent 4 years, the airline will add 54 further plane, taking its complete fleet dimension to 72.
