

## **Biman likely to resume Dubai, Abu Dhabi flights on March 11**

**Dhaka: Biman Bangladesh Airlines may resume its flights to Dubai and Abu Dhabi from Wednesday, March 11, subject to improvement of the Middle East situation and approval from airport authorities after a temporary suspension due to the ongoing regional crisis.**

According to a press release issued by the airline, flights on the Dubai and Abu Dhabi routes will remain suspended until March 10, 2026.

Meanwhile, Biman said four other Middle East destinations—Doha, Sharjah, Kuwait, and Dammam routes—will remain suspended until further instructions.

Biman authorities said the situation in the Middle East is being closely monitored, and passengers will be informed of any updates regarding

flight operations in due course.
