Cathay Pacific increases frequency on Dhaka_Hong Kong route

Dhaka: Cathay Pacific is adding another flight on its Dhaka-Hong Kong route, offering passengers more opportunities to travel. The airline will operate one additional flight a week on Tuesdays from September 5, 2023, said Cathay in a release.
