Dhaka: An Emirates flight EK 586 with special “United Arab Emirates 50” livery touched down in Dhaka on December 16, marking the Golden Jubilee of the UAE and Bangladesh this month. The arrival of the special decal aircraft celebrates a major milestone for both countries, and underscores Emirates’ long-standing commitment to Bangladesh.
