Emirates to resume services on Barcelona- Mexico City route

Dubai: As part of its endeavor to reopen connectivity Emirates will resume services to Mexico City (MEX) via Barcelona (BCN) from 2nd July 2021.

Four flights a week will be operated on the Barcelona- Mexico City route with a twoclass Boeing 777-200LR which offers 38 Business Class seats and 264 seats in Economy Class.

The resumed service between Dubai-Barcelona-Mexico will serve Emirates' customers in Mexico and offer more choice to travelers heading from Europe, India, South East Asia, and the Middle East via Dubai or Barcelona.

Emirates has safely and gradually restarted operations across its network. Since July Dubai is open for international business and leisure visitors. Mexico remains open for tourists and visitors as well.

COVID-19 pandemicEmirates has been offering flexible booking policies. Customers holding tickets issued before 30 September 2020 for travel before 31 December 2021, can now rebook to travel anytime within 36 months, an extension of 12 months from the previous policy. Those holding tickets issued after 01 October 2020 for travel before 31 December 2021, can utilize their tickets anytime within 36 months from the date of their original booking.

All Emirates customers are entitled to airlines' multi-risk travel insurance and COVID-19 cover. This cover is offered by Emirates on all tickets purchased on or from 1 December 2020.
