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Emirates will serve 12 US gateways following launch of a new service to Miami

Dubai: Emirates will launch a four times weekly service to Miami, from 22 July 2021, expanding its US network to 12 destinations in the USA.

With the addition of Miami, Emirates will now serve the US with over 70 weekly flights, offering over 26,000 seats across 12 gateways including Boston, Chicago, New York (JFK and Newark), Houston, Dallas, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Seattle, Washington DC, and Orlando.

The new service will also add to the existing trade connections provided by <u>Emirates SkyCargo</u>, the freight division of Emirates, which has been operating scheduled cargo flights to Miami since October 2020.

Flights to/from Miami will operate on Emirates' three-class <u>Boeing 777-300ER</u>, offering eight private suites in First Class, 42 lie-flat seats in Business Class, and 304 spacious seats in Economy Class.

Emirates has safely and gradually restarted operations across its network. Emirates hub city Dubai is open for international business and leisure visitors, since July 2020.

Emirates continues to lead the industry with innovative products and services that address traveler needs during a dynamic time. Recently the airline took its customer care initiatives further with even more generous and flexible booking policies, an extension of its multi-risk insurance cover, and helping loyal customers retain their miles and tier status.
