GoAir appoints ABC-AIR as GSA in Bangladesh

Dhaka: Indian budget airline GoAir will start flying to Bangladesh from November 26, 2020 under the Air Bubble Agreement signed between Bangladesh and India recently. The airline has appointed ABC-Air Ltd as their General Sales Agent (GSA) – passenger for the territory of Bangladesh.

Initially, GoAir flights will be operated on Thursdays and Saturdays. Flight G8-1540 will depart Kolkata at 10:50am and to arrive in Dhaka at 12:20pm. The return flight G8-4040 will depart Dhaka at 13:10pm to reach Kolkata at 13:40pm. Flight will be operated by Airbus A-320. One-way fare will start from BDT 6,200.00 and the return fare from BDT 11,400.00.

ABC-AIR Ltd., a leading travel and cargo transportation solution providers in Bangladesh started its operations in 1985. It served Emirates Airline and Korean Air as their GSA and PSA in Bangladesh for over 30 years.
