

Goodbye to the Queen of the Skies

Air India's iconic Boeing 747s may possibly have at last arrived at the conclusion of the street after colouring worldwide skies in the tricolour for in excess of 50 percent a century. The Tata Team not too long ago revamped the airline's web site and the jumbo jets are not demonstrated as part of the fleet.

The Directorate Standard of Civil Aviation (DGCA) experienced this April deregistered the Maharaja's past remaining 4 queen of the skies. If and when AI plans to use them once more for commercial flights, it will have to undergo a return to assistance program primary to their re-registration.
