Grameenphone, EBL bring smartphones on interestfree installments

Dhaka: Grameenphone, a leading telecommunications service provider of the country, has partnered with Eastern Bank PLC (EBL) to introduce an exclusive campaign, enabling its customers to purchase official smartphones from top brands with interest-free installment plans for up to 24 months.

Munia Ghani, Head of Partnerships of Grameenphone, and Tasnim Hussain, Head of Cards from EBL, recently signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to this effect at GPHouse in the capital.
