

## Indigo launches direct flights from Mumbai to Nairobi

**Mumbai: IndiGo has commenced new daily direct flights between Mumbai and Nairobi. Nairobi, Kenya's capital, and largest city is 27th international and 105th overall destination in IndiGo's network.**

The new route marks IndiGo's maiden flight into the African subcontinent.

With this direct connectivity, IndiGo aims to cater to the needs of both business and leisure travellers while fostering strategic bilateral ties between the two countries, contributing to economic growth.

“First time for IndiGo touching the African soil and we could not have chosen a better location to do so. This new route further enhances connectivity in the region as envisioned in IndiGo’s international growth strategy,” said Pieter Elbers, CEO of IndiGo.

Roads and Transport Cabinet Secretary Kipchumba Murkomen emphasized the government's commitment to improving air travel and infrastructure across Kenya.

“As part of our aviation development policy, we aim to create a more accessible and efficient air travel network within Kenya and beyond. Indigo Air's direct flights between Mumbai and Nairobi aligns perfectly with this vision,” he said.

With its fleet of over 300 aircraft, the airline is operating about 1900 daily flights and connecting 79 domestic destinations and will soon further grow its international footprint to 32 destinations.

Earlier, on Friday, Indigo crossed a significant milestone in its history by reaching 1,900 flights per day on its 17th anniversary.
