

## Iran extends flight ban over Israel tensions

Tehran: Iran's civil aviation organisation announced on Wednesday (Oct 2) that all flights will remain cancelled until Thursday (Oct 3) following Tehran's missile attacks on Israel, news agency reported.

The spokesperson for the organization, Jafar Yazarloo, made the announcement, adding that airlines will provide necessary updates regarding future flights amid the escalating tensions between Iran and Israel.

The decision was made after Iran's much-anticipated response to the occupying regime by striking Israeli targets deep inside the occupied Palestinian territories with a barrage of missiles on Tuesday evening.

In a statement, Iran's Islamic Revolution Guard Corps (IRGCC) said the missile strikes were in response to the Israeli assassination of Hezbollah leader, Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah, former Hamas chief Ismail Haniyeh

and IRGC commander General Abbas Nilforoushan.
