

Kuwait lifts ban on import of Bangladeshi frozen poultry products

Dhaka: The Government of Kuwait has lifted the ban on the import of frozen poultry meat, meat products, and eggs from Bangladesh, according to a notice issued by the Embassy of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in Kuwait.

In a notification circulated to Bangladeshi expatriate business communities, the embassy said the restriction previously imposed on the import of all kinds of Bangladeshi frozen poultry meat, meat products, and eggs has now been withdrawn by the Kuwaiti authorities.

The decision will allow Bangladeshi exporters and expatriate traders in Kuwait to resume imports of the listed products from Bangladesh. The embassy urged all concerned Bangladeshi businesspersons to take note of the updated decision and proceed accordingly.

The notice was signed by Mohammad Moniruzzaman, Counsellor and Head of Chancery of the Bangladesh Embassy in Kuwait, and was issued on 15 January 2026.
