

## Oman Air increases flights to key Indian cities

The national air carrier of Oman, Oman Air has decided to increase the frequency of flights to and from India. The airline is boosting frequency to 8 Indian cities, bringing it to a total of 161 flights per week to boost the tourism sector.

The air carrier will operate 8 flights per week to Bangalore, Mumbai, Kozhikode, Kochi, Delhi, Hyderabad, Chennai and 3 flights per week to Goa.
