

## Pakistan to install modern scanners at major airports

Dhaka: The Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority (PCAA) will install state-of-the-art scanning machines at major airports in Pakistan. The move is aimed at strengthening aviation security and improving passenger convenience.

Previously, the PCAA, along with the Pakistan Airports Authority (PAA) and the Airports Security Force (ASF), conducted a joint survey to identify the most suitable airports for the new equipment.

Media reports said the installation process is set to begin soon, starting with Karachi Airport, followed by Islamabad and Lahore.

The PCAA stated the multi-billion-rupee initiative will speed up the luggage screening process and significantly enhance airport security. Moreover, advanced scanners will play a key role in preventing smuggling.

Passengers are expected to experience smoother and faster security checks when the new systems become operational.

Officials remarked the project underscored the authority's commitment to safety and efficiency for ensuring travelers a secure and hassle-free air travel experience.
