

Riyadh to host major hospitality conference to boost tourism

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Dhaka: Saudi Arabia's Future Hospitality Summit (FHS), a leading hospitality investment event, will return to Riyadh for its 9th edition, taking place from 20 to 22 April 2026 at the Mandarin Oriental Al Faisaliah.

The summit continues to play a vital role in the Kingdom's Vision 2030 plan to transform Saudi Arabia into a global tourism hub.

The 2025 edition attracted over 1,100 global investors and decision-makers, with significant announcements, including 11 major hotel signings. In total, USD 1.6 billion in business opportunities were reported, further cementing FHS as the region's top deal-making platform.
