

SpiceJet flight makes emergency landing at Delhi airport

In yet another incident, a SpiceJet aircraft operating from Delhi to Jabalpur returned to the Delhi airport on Saturday (July 2) morning after the crew noticed smoke in the cabin.

The flight was at an altitude of 5000ft.

A SpiceJet spokesperson said that all the passengers were safely disembarked.

A video of passengers in the flight filled with smoke was tweeted by the agency.

This is the second incident reported in 15 days. On June 19, a Delhi-bound SpiceJet plane, carrying 185 passengers and six crew members, made an emergency landing in Patna on Sunday afternoon, minutes after its take-off, as its cabin crew witnessed sparks coming from an engine, a senior government official said.
