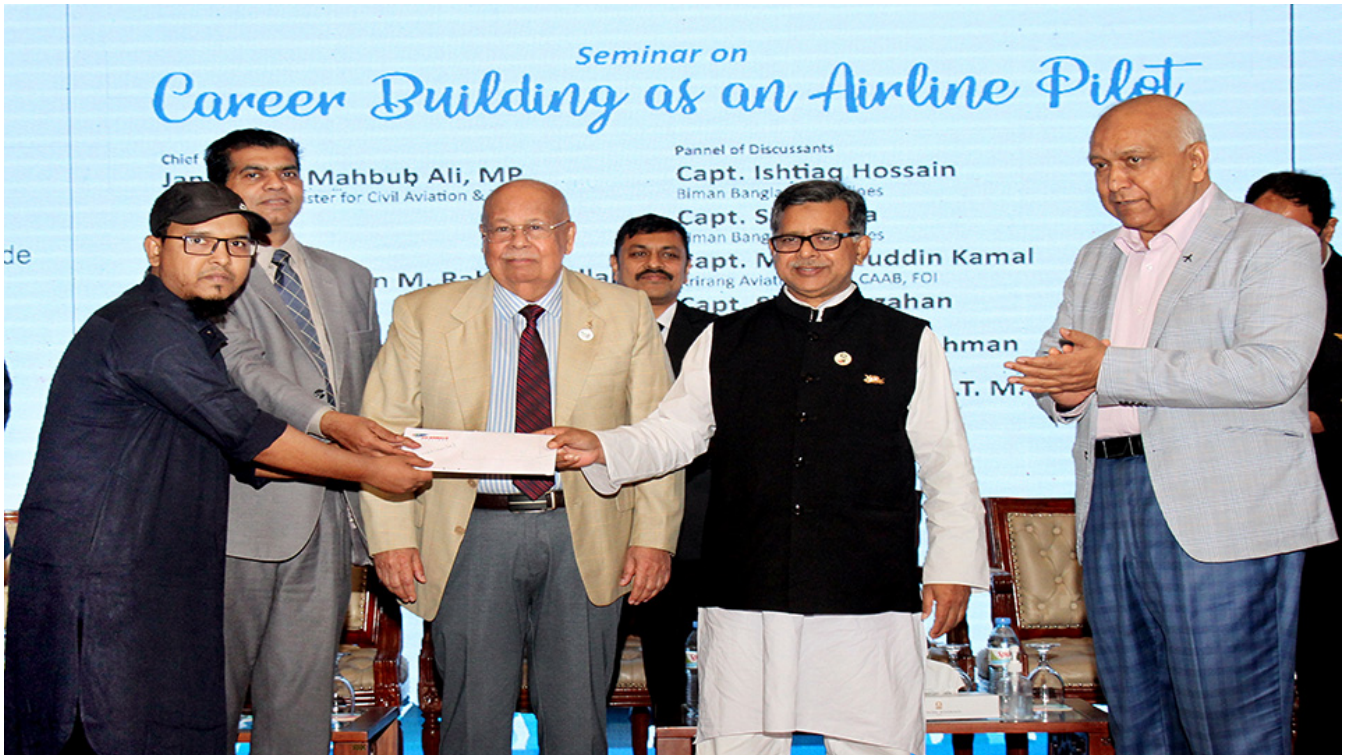


Visitors win attractive raffle draw prizes at job, career fair in BD travel trade
