Dhaka: Passengers can enjoy watching the popular TV reality game show Krishoker Eid Ananda written, directed and hosted by the renowned media personality Shykh Seraj from August 1, 2022 on all Emirates flights.

The airline is operating 21 weekly flights to and from Dhaka and via Dubai passengers can fly to about 130 destinations in Emirates' network across the world.
